1) <u>Welcome and introduction</u>

President Anna Van Adrichem Rochon thanked everyone for coming out and noted the full business agenda and a presentation.

- <u>Treasurer's Report Colin Leech</u>
  We are currently under budget as a result of savings made. The current membership fee is \$65.
